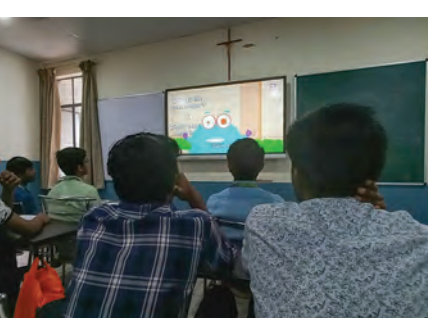

CLOUD COMPUTING

A Seminar on "Cloud Computing and its Applications" was organized by the Department of BCA, Bosco Technical Training Society, Okhla Road, New Delhi on 29th September 2022. The following seminar was conducted by one of the well established companies of India, Big Basket. Both the batches of BCA were present at the seminar. (A brief about the instructor)

Dr. Ruchi Sawhney started his session with the basic concepts of cloud computing. He explained Cloud computing has emerged as a revolutionary paradigm through which organizations can optimize their Information and Communication Technology (ICT) investments. Cloud computing is an emerging paradigm in the computer industry where the computing is moved to a cloud of computers. It has become one of the buzzwords of the industry.

This seminar introduced the important concepts and terminology for working with Cloud Platforms. Learned about, and compared, many of the services



available in Google Cloud Platform, including Cloud Storage, Cloud Spanner, Cloud Bigtable, Google App Engine, etc. He also explained Cloud Computing pay-as-you-go manner to the general public, we call it a Public Cloud; the service being sold is Utility Computing. Last 15 minutes' questionnaire session went in a more interactive manner where students cleared all their respective doubts. The Seminar went well. Everybody learned a lot and it was such a knowledgeable seminar that the topics taught to us will be very useful in our future career.

He gave deep insights on the mistakes which candidates make while attending interviews and explained how to overcome those mistakes. He explained how to give the answers very effectively of certain questions like,

- ❖ Why should we hire you?
- ❖ Where do you see yourself 5 years from now?
- ❖ What are your strengths and weaknesses?
- ❖ When can you join if selected?
- ❖ How much salary do you expect?
- ❖ What do you know about our company?



Mr. Ruchir explained all the scenarios of Interview Environment. He also elaborated the ways of explaining and justifying the answers of various questions and make a very good impression on the interviewer. He concluded the session by motivating everyone to stay calm and positive during the interview process. Students learnt about the various aspects of facing interviews and are now one step closer to the preparation needed for facing such interviews.

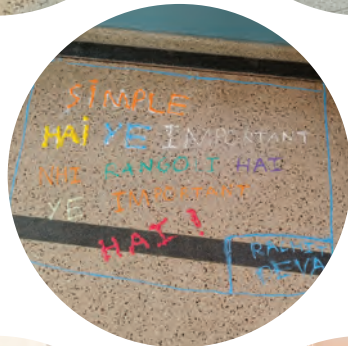

Children's Day Celebration

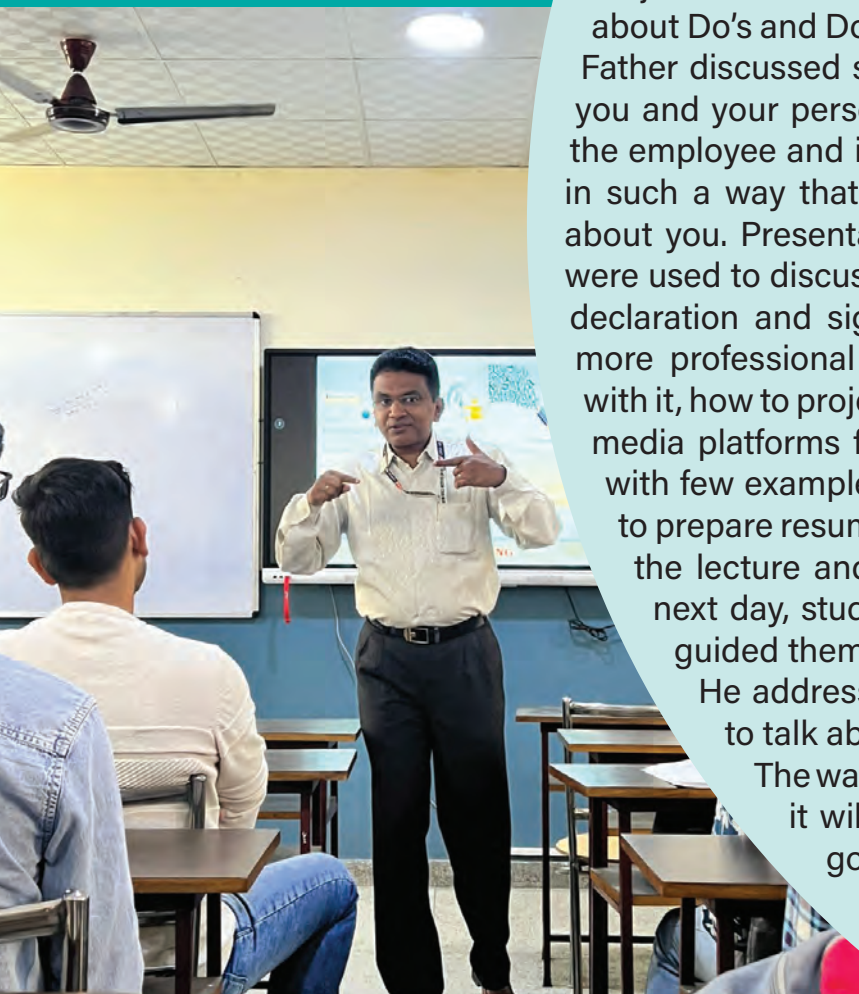

CHRISTMAS EVENT

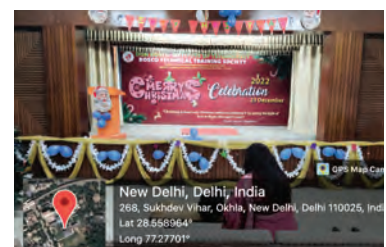

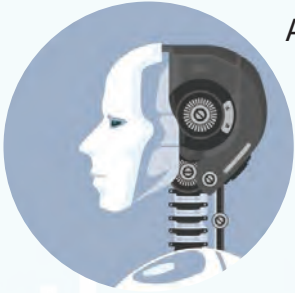

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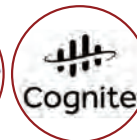
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
