














# Industrial Visit To Yakult-Sonepat, Haryana

An industrial visit is the first point of interaction between a student and a live working industry. The students learn about the latest technology trend and make up their minds about their future job or area of interest. Industrial visits also seem to present networking opportunities for the students with the company's HR, thereby increasing the opportunities for internships, placements, etc., for students. The domain wisdom and practical outlook towards the industry & requisite skills for the industry is also known to the students.

Don Bosco Institute of Technology, Delhi gave our students of BBA, BCA and B.Com the opportunity for an industrial visit to Yakult, stated in Sonepat, Haryana. 50 students of BBA, B.Com and BCA along with 2 faculty members went for the industrial visit. They started with the plant section where the raw material, that is, milk was being pasteurized. After that they visited to the next department where bacteria culture mixing, sugar syrup mixing and fermentation was being done. Next process was packaging bottle preparation and quality control. After that they visited Quality Control Check and at last final packaging was being done.

The students saw some machines, huge boilers and storage tanks in the manufacturing area. 
### **CHRISTMAS EVENT**
