- The manuscript should not exceed 4000 words with an abstract length of 200-250 words
- A soft copy of the paper should be submitted in A-4 size, MS Word format only with Times New Roman with a heading in font size 14 and remaining text size 12 with double spacing
- Reference should be in APA format
- Table/Annexures/Figures should be given at the appropriate place with proper connectivity in the manuscript of the paper
- All papers will undergo peer review, the blind review process, and plagiarism/quality check
- At least one of the authors must complete registration before the inclusion of the research paper in the conference proceedings. If there is more than one author in any paper any one of the authors can only present the paper during the conference
- Certificates will be given to all authors which should not exceed more than three in a single paper
- All accepted papers will be published in the form of a Conference Proceeding/Edited Book with ISBN No.
